EACH AREA AND WHAT IT OFFERS:

Nadi

- Fiji's third largest city also, serves as the "gateway" to Fiji and the South Pacific
- Nadi offers restaurants of every kind of cuisine, bars, nightclubs, curio shops for the passionate shopper and a colorful marketplace featuring local cultural art.
- Beautiful orchid collection at the Garden of the Sleeping Giant established by US actor Raymond Burr, Subramanian Swami Temple, hiking, golf and so much more

Denarau Island & Coral Coast

- Denarau Islands is the biggest concentration of activity in Fiji, with 71 stores for world-class shopping dining and "play" experience etc.

- The arc-shaped Mamanuca chain is situated inside the outer MaloloReef whose protective barrier creates excellent conditions for sailing, scuba diving, snorkeling straight off the beach and a wide range of water-based activities

Vanua Levu

- Fiji's second largest island is an amazing blend of warm hospitality, pine forests, fabulous rainforests, sand beaches and has one of the world's longest barrier reefs.
