November – March (Summer) is the hot/wet season, with the average temperature being 83

### The Secret Garden

An informative guide will show you around this lush garden telling legends and stories about the island. A natural habitat for a wide range of wildlife, the Secret Garden is home to: birds, wild ducks, parrots, foxes, crabs, snakes, lizards and turtles, among many more. Houses, dating back hundreds of years grace the area, adding culture and history to the tour. The area now includes a swimming pool and BBQ area, which gives a place to relax and cool off during the walking tour. In case you are hungry, there is a restaurant with a bar in the vicinity.

## Hideaway Island Tour
